We live to see the smiling faces of our beautiful students who light up our lives each day.

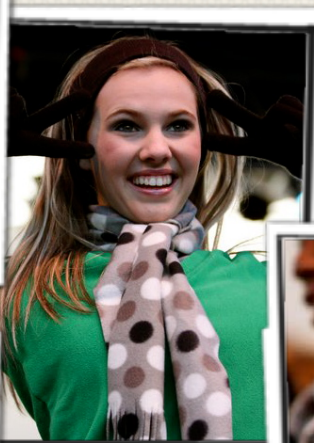
